"I mean the most difficult is, that we have no data and a lot of it comes actually after you've run the car for the first time in the first practice session. But we are very reliant on your work that you do in the simulator for example, many people maybe



don't realize that. What we'll do is we'll have a scan of the circuit, so we'll understand how the corners are laid out, what the angles are, little bit about the tarmac is, what the ride is. And what we'll do before we've even gone there, we'll not only do strategically 100,000-200,000 simulations and with the car setup something at the same number."
